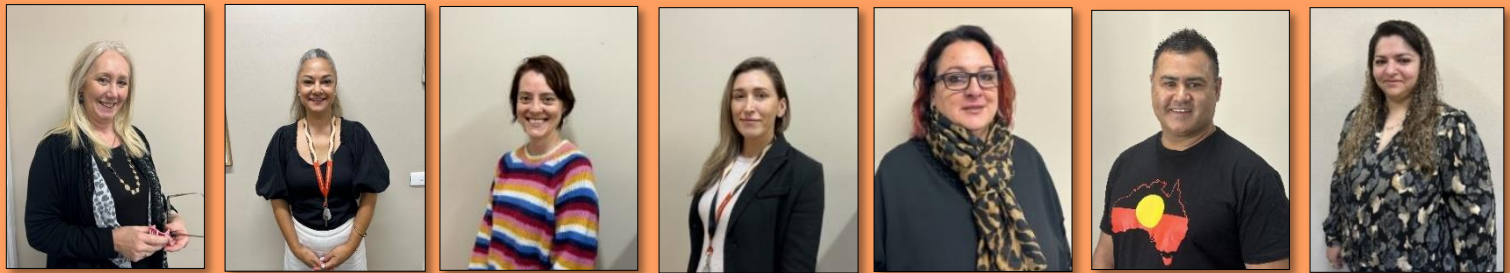
**Respect** - We demonstrate respect through our actions and behaviours for ourselves, our organisation, our community, and our culture.
